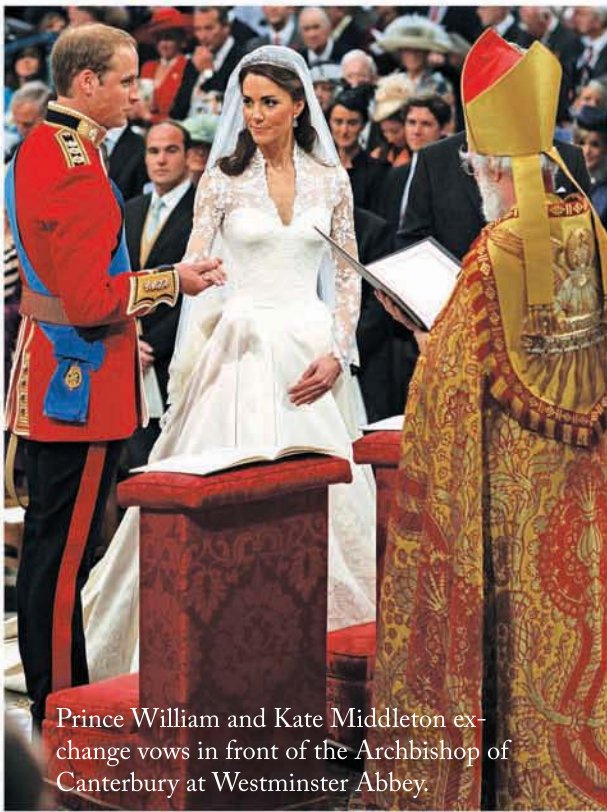

SUPERHERO MOVIE SPOTLIGHT:

The Green Lantern

Ryan Reynolds leads the pack in one of the season's hottest superhero movies.

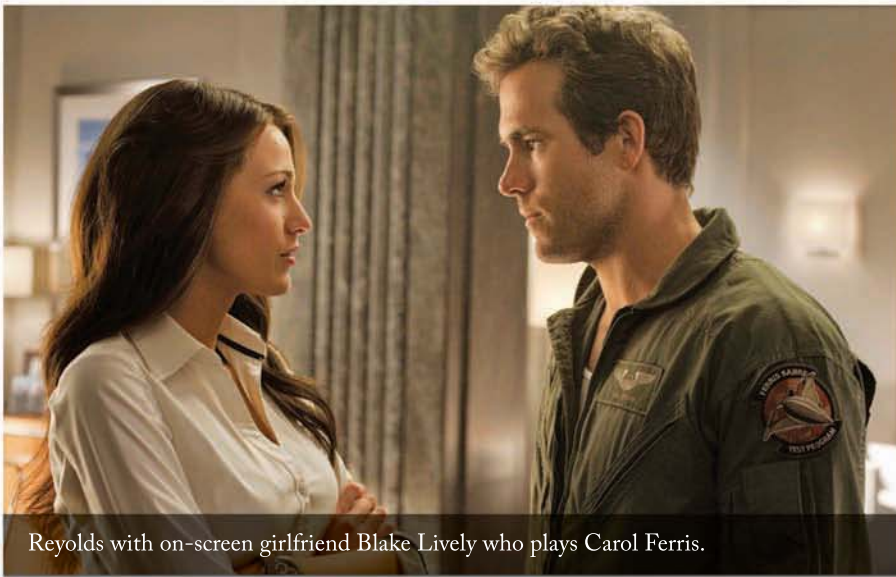

Hal Jordan is the latest in a long line of Green Lanterns—a centuries-old series of intergalactic do-gooders who, of course, have supernatural powers. Hal's biggest hurdle is the fact that he's the first human to take on the role, which also happens to be his greatest strength.

Canadian superstar Ryan Reynolds plays Hal (a.k.a. Green Lantern), a skilled but brash test pilot who has to find away to defeat Parallax, an evil super-villain with a cool name.

As for the Green Lantern suit, Reynolds explained at Comic-Con, "The suit is a manifestation

of Hal's will and imagination. It's not something that he puts on; it's something that comes out of him. In order to do that properly you have to use technology." He joked, "I'm not going to let them put a suit inside my body and then rip it out through my skin. And I'm glad, because they did suggest that at the beginning."

Of course, not only does the Green Lantern create constructs from his imagination, but Reynolds also had to re-imagine this cool world when filming against a blue screen.

“Part of it is make-believe and when you are working on a movie such as this, you have to embrace that thing when you are a child, the yearning to pretend,” he says. “I saw a bit of footage, but you can’t ever know that stuff going in,”

Reynolds told Collider.com. “That’s something that you have to have a lot of faith in your studio. And I look at Warner Bros. and their track record with *Harry Potter* and these big tent-pole movies—they do such a great job with all of it. They spend the money, which is

what it comes down to, really. So you have faith in that regard and you just do whatever you can. I’m the actor of the movie and I have to bring that to life. That’s all I can focus on.”

Bringing *The Green Lantern* to the screen has taken almost the better part of two decades. At one point, the project was even conceived as a comedy starring Jack Black, but an Internet backlash put a stop to that idea. Even Quentin Tarantino claims that he was offered the chance to direct. Everyone from Justin Timberlake to Bradley Cooper was considered for the lead role. But as Cooper recently told MTV, “I did get a chance to try out for it, which was amazing...Ryan Reynolds got it—who, by the way, if I was directing the

movie, I would cast him. He’s perfect. He actually looks like a superhero.”

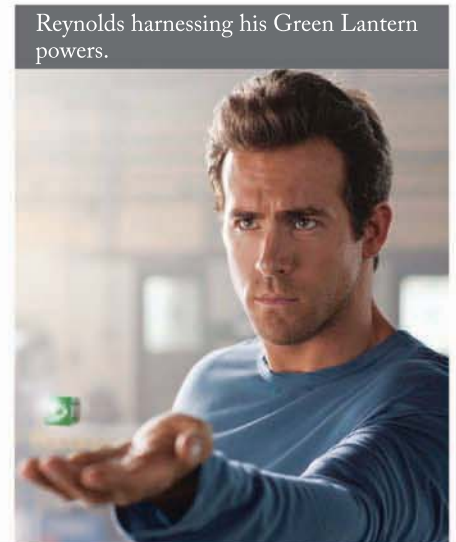
Of course, any actor, when creating a comic-book character on the big screen, must consider the potential backlash of not living up to the fanboys’ expectations. For Reynolds, it was a big consideration. “Movies like this are such a leap of faith. I spent six months just staring at a big, blank wall,” Reynolds admitted. “So I am doing my part of the job. I fulfilled my part of the bargain. So you hope everyone else does this right.”

Reynolds admits his knowledge of the *Green Lantern* comic books was lacking and to in order to fill the gaps, he current *Green Lantern* comic writer Geoff Johns on set while filming. “I didn’t know much about it. I knew the log line – guy is given a ring by a dying guy and becomes a superhero,” he said at Comic-Con. “Geoff Johns was great to have around on set because he was the mythology police. When you have an executive producer that is also a fanboy, he definitely made sure everything was up to snuff.”

Ryan’s co-stars include Oscar winners Tim Robbins (*Mystic River*) and Geoffrey Rush (*The King’s Speech*), as well as Peter Saarsgard, Mark Strong, Angela Bassett and the lovely Blake Lively as Hal’s girlfriend, Carol Ferris.



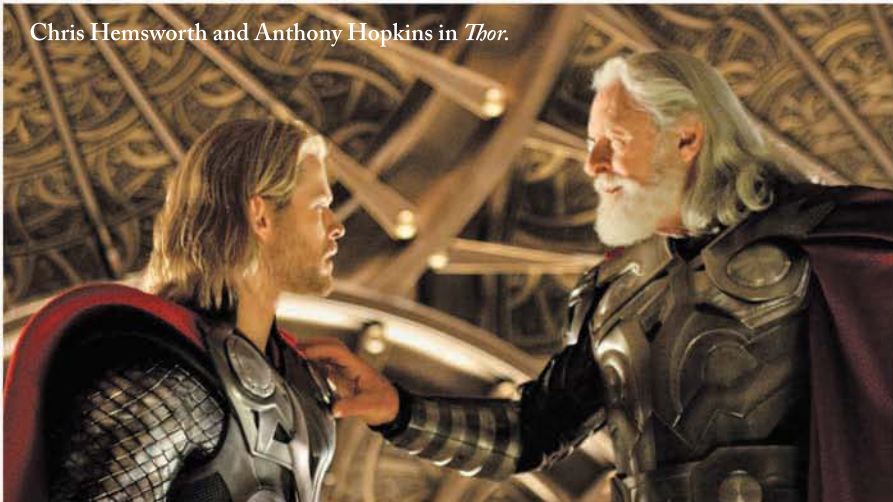
Reynolds talks to one of the Green Lanterns on their native planet of Oa.

Talk about being grounded! When Thor ticks off his father (for the crime of reigniting a bitter war), his punishment is severe: he is banished to live on Earth. While that may not sound so bad to you and me, to Thor it's the equivalent of a

teen having his text privileges revoked for life. However, Thor gets his chance at redemption when he defends the people of Earth from an attack by the dark forces of Asgard.

Thor features an impressive cast, including rising Aussie star Chris Hemsworth in the title role, Oscar winner Natalie Portman as scientist Jane Foster, Rene Russo, Kat Dennings and Oscar-winner Anthony Hopkins as the royally ticked-off father, Odin. So what would draw the in-demand Portman

into a superhero flick? Portman's a big fan of the movie's director, Kenneth Branagh, and it also appealed to her that the Jane Foster character from the Thor comics was being upgraded from nurse to astrophysicist. "What a great opportunity, in a very big movie that is going to be seen by a lot of people, to have a woman as a scientist," she told the *L.A. Times*. "It is those little things that make girls think it's possible."

Although Hemsworth was originally passed over for the role, he was given a second chance and made good on the opportunity. He believes that despite all of the special effects, the real trick is to find the humanity in the character.

They also found the hilarity. There are many funny moments in the movie, mostly as the earthlings try to deal with this fish-out-of-water Norse god, who eats Pop-Tarts by the dozen and orders another coffee by grandly smashing his cup. And of course, the local chicks love him because he has great pecs.

Thor is the first in a series, of sorts. The character (again played by Hemsworth) will appear in the Marvel film *The Avengers*, set for release in 2012.

X-MEN: FIRST CLASS

Long before they were enemies, they were best friends. *X-Men: First Class* tells the story of how eventual arch-rivals Professor Charles Xavier, played by James McAvoy (*Wanted*, *Atonement*), and Erik Lehnsherr/Magneto, played by Michael Fassbender (*300*, *Jane Eyre*), originally teamed up to fight a common enemy.

Set during the tense days of the Cuban Missile Crisis, the young idealists are alarmed when president John F. Kennedy tells the world of a potential nuclear confrontation between the U.S.A. and Cuba.

Rooting the plot in actual events gives this *X-Men* prequel added dramatic heft. Although James McAvoy is far too young to remember those tense days, he loves the fact that the film is set in history. "We sort of attach ourselves to history really closely in quite a strong way, but then we also mess with history quite a lot and re-write it a little bit," he recently told IGN Movies. "We don't change the outcome of any world events, but the explanation and the kind of

machine behind those world events we kind of play off the mutants, which is great."

Rounding out the terrific cast is Kevin Bacon (as the leader of the Hellfire Club), *Mad Men* star January Jones as Emma Frost (and *The White Queen*), *Damages* star Rose Byrne (as Moira McTaggart), and recent Oscar nominee (*Winter's Bone*) Jennifer Lawrence (Raven/Mystique).

Although this is the fifth film in the *X-Men* series, it is rumored to be the first in a new *X-Men* prequel trilogy.

The Bang Bang Club was the nickname given to a group of four photographers—Greg Marinovich (Phillippe), Kevin Carter (Kitsch), Ken Oosterbroek (Rautenbach) and Joao Silva (Van Jaarsveld)—in South Africa who risked their lives with their photos that captured the final bloody days of white rule in South Africa and the final demise of apartheid. Their heroic story recounts their relationships, stresses, tensions and moral dilemmas of working in situations of extreme violence, pain and suffering. *Tribute's* Toni-Marie Ippolito spoke to Phillippe and Malin Akerman—who stars as Robin, their daring photo editor—about filming this intense story, what it was like on-set in South Africa, and African safaris!

One thing that comes to mind immediately about this group is the moral dilemma. They shot photos as they happened but didn't interfere or help.

Phillippe: Without a doubt, South Africa is one of the most traumatic and complex places on the planet—the country's history, the changes that it's still going through, is really fascinating to me. These guys were like adrenaline junkies. They're only photographers, but they really do have the mindset of fighter pilots. They really have no fear... and that appealed to me.

Akerman: I think they're heroes. One of the actual photographers, Kevin Carter, actually committed suicide over this moral dilemma, because he felt like he wasn't doing enough because he was just taking pictures. But the thing is, not one person can stop a civil war, and instead of shooting guns, they went out and shot with cameras and let the rest of the world know what was going on.

Could you ever imagine yourself doing this job?

Phillippe: Well, to an extent I am fearless, and when I've played soldiers in the past and I've had to do training, I feel that I'm of that mentality that I could handle those situations. What would be difficult for me would be not getting involved. To be a direct witness to such extreme violence and mistreatment, with fear aside, I don't know how you'd try and stop it.

Akerman: It's just one of those things in

humanity that if you're around and a kid who falls down and breaks his arm and you see the bone popping out, some people are really queasy, but if it's just you, you go into survival mode. I think it would be the same kind of thing that would happen to me, and with Robin, it's that people were getting killed every single day and the only thing she could do about it was to print these images to help, and that that was her duty.

Shooting this movie must have been grueling.

Phillippe: This was probably the most intense and grueling shoot I've ever had in my entire life. We were six days a week in some of the poorest places on the planet. There were times when we were shooting that I was knee-deep in sewage, which was unpleasant to experience for one or two days, but there were people living in it, so that definitely has an effect on you. Also, as a father, being in these townships and seeing these kids during the week, not in school, sitting in a puddle playing with a beer bottle. It definitely gives you an appreciation of what you do have, and you're never prepared for it.

What was it like working with Malin? You guys had great chemistry.

Phillippe: She's a lot of fun. She was kind of like one of the guys. When you do a movie like this, you're in South Africa and it's a difficult shoot and lower budget, you tend to bond with each other. We were

so isolated and far from home and our comfort zone.

What was it like working with Ryan and the cast?

Akerman: It was so great! We got along so well. I always appreciate when an actor comes in prepared and they're really committed and they want the film to be great. Then, everything else just flows. And that was Ryan. We were all together in the same hotel for six weeks, hanging out every night, having dinner every night, practicing our accents and just having a blast.

Did you get to go on an African safari while you were there?

Malin: I did! Once I was done shooting, one of my sisters flew down from Sweden and we took a three-day safari in Kruger National Park and it was beautiful! We saw all the most amazing animals!

Prince William & Kate Middleton Wed

With the entire world watching, Prince William and Catherine Middleton became husband and wife on Friday, April 29, 2011 in London, England. Now officially married, the couple have been gifted the new titles of Duke and Duchess of Cambridge by Her Majesty the Queen. Although many were hailing Kate a “princess,” she was not given that official title.

The wedding, rivaling that of Prince Charles and Princess Diana’s 1981 nuptials, is the fairy-tale ending to a long love story that spawned a media frenzy since the pair first met during their university days at St. Andrews, only to increase when they announced their engagement last fall.

With brother and best man Prince Harry sporting the uniform of Captain of the Household Cavalry by his side, William, 28, wearing the scarlet uniform of the Colonel of the Irish Guards, slipped a traditional Welsh gold wedding band on Middleton’s finger.

Friends, family, foreign dignitaries and a handful of celebrities were among the 1900 guests invited to the royal wedding, including Rowan Atkinson (Mr. Bean), David and Victoria Beckham, Elton John and David Furnish, Guy Ritchie and Joss Stone.

Kate’s simple yet elegant wedding gown was designed by Sarah Burton of Alexander McQueen and she wore a Cartier “halo” tiara lent to her by the Queen.

The wedding was followed by a lunchtime service at St. James’s Palace hosted by the Queen, then by a private evening reception at Buckingham Palace for 300 guests.
